THE CREATION OF MANY OF OUR MUNICIPAL PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS IN NORWICH SUCH AS EATON PARK.

EDUCATED AT NORWICH HIGH
SCHOOL FOR GIRLS, DOROTHY
JEWSON BECAME A MEMBER OF
CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY OF
WOMENS'S SUFFRAGE SOCIETY
WHILST AT UNIVERSITY. SHE THEN
JOINED THE WOMEN'S SOCIAL AND
POLITICAL UNION (WSPU), FOUNDED
BY EMMELINE PANKHURST.
